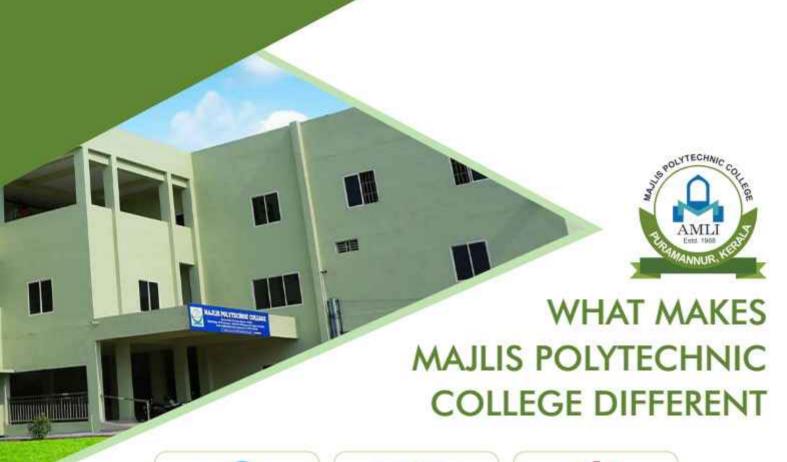

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

- The Candidate Should be a Citizen of India
- The Candidate Should have passed SSLC/THSLC or equivalent examination, with eligibility for higher studies.
- Candidates who have passed qualifying examination with Mathematics, English and Science subjects are eligible to apply.
- For CBSE / ICSE candidates, the Marks/Grade obtained in science is considered for calculating grade in Science, in the place of Physics and Chemistry. In the case of CBSE candidates, only the certificates of Board Examination shall be accepted as qualifying certificate and such candidates shall submit an Undertaking (annexure-I) at the time of admission and a copy of the same shall be submitted along with the application.

Merit

50 % of seats will be on merit filled by Department of Technical Education

Management Seat

50% of seats will be filled by management from the rank list prepared on the basis of index mark considering the eligibility conditions fixed by Director of Technical Education.

The application and prospectus will also be available from Polytechnic college office on payment of Rs. 200/- The filled up application is to be submitted in the Polytechnic college office. The application fee can be remitted in the Polytechnic College at the time of submission of application, along with relevant documents.

General Conditions

- The selection list for allotment will be prepared on the basis of the index mark obtained
- For candidates who have secured eligibility for higher studies in the second score will be deducted as the penal point for index score calculation, chance, 0.5
- The index score is obtained after subtracting the penal points if any to the Total Grade Point Average (TGPA) Uniforms and college identification Card are compulsory for the students.
- The uniform will be a combination of golden yellow shirt with black pants.
- Girl students are permitted to wear black churidar with golden yellow top and black waist coat. All candidates shall be accompanied by their parent/guardian at the time of admission.
- All candidates selected for admission and their parent/ guardians should give a combined undertaking in the prescribed format (Annexure -ii) that he/she was not involved in any ragging activity in the past and that he/she would not indulge in it in future. If the undertaking is violated, the students would liable to be expelled. (Directives of the Hon. Supreme Court of India)

Class timings are from 9.00 am to 4.30 pm on all days except second Saturdays and Sundays. Attendance will be recorded on each period. Late coming is not allowed. List of other idays will be displayed on the College Notice Board at the beginning of each calendaryear.



Attendance

Rules given by the Board of Technical Education in the matter of attendance will be strictly enforced. The students should co operate with the college authorities in the matter and in all other activities aimed at their welfare. No relaxation or concession will be extended by the Management. All Students should wear the prescribed uniform within a forth night from the day of commencement of classes. After this date, students who are not in the prescribed uniform and are not properly groomed in their appearance will not be permitted to sit in the class.

Evaluation

Apart from the end term examinations we follow a system of continous evaluation for assessment of student performance, weightage is given for internal assessment based on attendance, class participation, assignments, workshop and lab work, conduct on campus, punctuality, utilisation of library and computer centre etc.

Ragging Strictly Prohibited Extract from Govt. Order on Ragging

Ragging / any type of miscondcut towards any students, either in the college campus or outside, will be considered as criminal offence and will be immediately reported to the police. Preparators will not be permitted to continue their studies. Every student shall at the time of admission furnish a character certificate from the institute where from he/she has passed the qualifying examination, which would mention the status of his/her behavioral pattern especially in terms as to whether he/ she has displayed persistent violent or aggressive behavior or and desire to harm others. Students and parents shall, at the time of admission, furnish an affidavit to the effect that the students shall not indulge in ragging.

Refund Policy

Any candidate who joined the Diploma Programme and discontinued his/her study after the closure of admission will be liable to pay the entire course fee for the issuance of transfer certificate.

General Behavior

- Students are expected to maintain dignity and decorum on all occasions.
- The college properties should be handled with utmost care. Students shall not disfigure the walls, windows or furniture by writing on them or sticking bills or graffiti.
- Students are not allowed to loiter in the verandas and the campus during class hours. Students are also not allowed to enter other classes.
- Indecent behaviour towards teachers and fellow students will not be compromised.
- Students should not be absent from the class without proper leave letter signed by their parents.
- 75% of attendance in regular classes and good progress and conduct are compulsory for appearing for end semester Diploma Examinations and for promotion to higher classes.

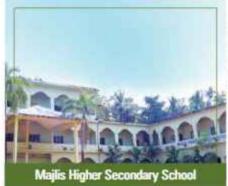






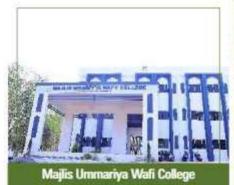


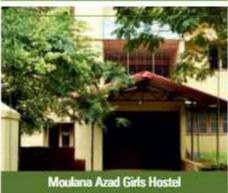
